Bubble 1: Registered team members

* Where personal terms are used in the masculine form only, they refer to men and women in the same way.

1. General regulations

- Keep distance (1.5 m)
- Observe hygiene measures
- Use Corona warning app/Luca app
- It is compulsory to wear a mouth/nose protection (OP mask/FFP2 mask) on the entire event site, an exception applies only to the deviation listed under 7. point 4.
- Please use the disinfectants available on the event premises. Before entering the Corona Test Center, the Accreditation Center, and the Zollern-Alb-Halle, it is mandatory to thoroughly disinfect your hands
- Pay attention to the signs on the event premises
- Persons who do not comply with the applicable regulations will have their accreditation withdrawn

2. bubble 1 is given access to the following areas

- Corona test center: Erich-Kästner Straße 30, 72461 Albstadt
- Accreditation Center: Thalia Theater at Thaliastraße 9, 72461 Albstadt
- Expo-Area Teams: Thaliastrasse 9 or parking lot Zollern-Alb-Halle, Untere Bachstrasse 135 in 72461 Albstadt
- Event area: Competition course, stage area, interview zone
- Zollern-Alb-Halle: Info-Point, Anti-Doping, Bikewash

3. information request

- All members of bubble 1 must provide full contact details to the organizer in advance. The organizer will take into account the rules of the DSGVO in this regard:

- Only the participants registered in advance and who have submitted their data to the organizer will receive an access authorization for the event area

4. procedure for all people of the bubble 1

a) Corona Test Center:

- Submission of a **daily negative test** in English, French or German from a test centers of municipalities/cities, service providers, pharmacies or doctors
- or performance of a Corona rapid test in the test center by the DRK Zollernalb
- In case of a negative test result, you will receive a color-coded admission wristband that grants access to the event area for the day on which the test was performed. In case of a positive test result, you must immediately have a PCR swab performed at the test center. The entire team of the person tested positive will be required to go into segregation
- Segregation must take place in a suitable facility (segregation site) in accordance with Section § 30 (1) of the Infection Protection Act (IfSG). The duration of the segregation is determined by the Zollernalbkreis Health Department and is measured according to § 3 of the Corona Ordinance Segregation

- The test center is scheduled to be open at the following times:

Sunday	09.05.2021	06:00 - 17:00

- On Saturday and Sunday there is the possibility to have a PCR test performed. The results will be transferred digitally to the smartphone via a QR code.
- The costs for the rapid tests (20 € per test), and PCR tests (90 €) must be paid on site by the respective person to be tested. We ask preferably for cashless payment

b) Accreditation center

- With the entrance wristband from the Corona Test Center you will get access to the Accreditation Center
- Once you have been accredited, you will receive another entry wristband with the inscription "Team" in the color neon coral
- With both bands you will get access to the common areas listed under 2.

5. Arrival

- Information on entering Germany can be found on the information sheet "Overview of entry and quarantine regulations".
- Please travel in fixed groups and refrain from carpooling with external escorts
- If you travel by public transport, the hygiene regulations of the public transport operator apply.
- If traveling in a team bus, limit the number of people to the athletes and those directly involved. Please pay best attention to the distance and wear a mouth-nose protection

6. Team Area | Accommodation

- The distance between the entrances of the stands and tents on the team area must be 1.5 m
- When making accommodations, please make sure that you are in a fixed group and remain permanently in that group. Mixing with other teams should be avoided if possible
- If you have to complete a quarantine after your entry, please clarify this with your accommodation in advance

7. Training and competition

- Refrain from greeting rituals, high-fives, cheering together
- Bring your own water bottle
- Public spitting and nose blowing is prohibited
- Masks must be worn until positioned at the start and finish areas. During the training and the competition the athletes are exempted from the obligation to wear a mouth-nose-protector

8. Interview zone

- Interviews are allowed only outdoors in compliance with the distance
- There is a designated zone for this purpose at the Zollern-Alb-Halle
