Bubble 3: Media representatives

(Who have accredited themselves via the organizer)

* Where personal terms are used in the masculine form only, they refer to men and women in the same way.

1. General regulations

- Keep distance (1.5 m)
- Observe hygiene measures
- Use Corona warning app/Luca app
- It is compulsory to wear mouth-nose protection (OP mask/FFP2- mask) on the entire event site
- Please use the disinfectants available on the event site
- In the Corona Test Center, in the Accreditation Center, and in the Press Center in the Zollern-Alb-Halle, it is mandatory to wear an FFP2-mask. There is also an obligation to thoroughly disinfect hands before entering
- Pay attention to the signage on the event site
- Persons who do not comply with the applicable regulations will have their accreditation revoked

2. bubble 3 gets access to the following staging areas

- Test center: Erich-Kästner Straße 30, 72461 Albstadt
- Accreditation Center: Thalia-Theater, Thaliastraße 9, 72461 Albstadt
- Zollern-Alb-Halle Press center: Untere Bachstraße 135, 72461 Albstadt

3. Information request

- All members of the bubble 3 must provide full contact details to the organizer in advance. The organizer takes the rules of the DSGVO into account here <https://app.smartsheet.com/b/form/a4d5823865dc4dd3ac179e768acb17ae>
- Only the media representatives registered in advance and who have submitted their data to the organizer will receive an access authorization for the event area

4. Procedure for all people of the bubble 3

a) Corona Test Center:

- Submission of a **daily negative test** in English, French or German from a test centers of municipalities/cities, service providers, pharmacies or doctors
- or performance of a Corona rapid test in the test center by the DRK Zollernalb
- In case of a negative test result, you will receive a color-coded admission wristband that grants access to the event area for the day on which the test was performed and the following day
- In case of a positive test result, you must immediately have a PCR swab performed at the test center. The entire team of the person tested positive will be required to go into segregation. Segregation must take place in a suitable facility (segregation site) in accordance with Section § 30 (1) of the Infection Protection Act (IfSG). The duration of the segregation is determined by the Zollernalbkreis Health Department and is measured according to § 3 of the Corona Ordinance Segregation

- The test center is scheduled to be open at the following times:

Saturday	08.05.2021	06:00 - 16:00
Sunday	09.05.2021	06:00 - 17:00

- On Saturday and Sunday there is the possibility to have a PCR test performed. The results will be transferred digitally to the smartphone via a QR code.
- The costs for the rapid tests (20 €), and PCR tests (90 €) must be paid on site by the respective person to be tested. We ask preferably for cashless payment

b) Accreditation center

- With the entrance wristband from the Corona Test Center you will get access to the Accreditation Center
- As soon as you have been accredited, you will receive another admission wristband with the inscription "Press" in the color neon pink
- With both bands you will get access to the common areas listed under 2

5. Arrival

- Information on entering Germany can be found on the information sheet "Overview of entry and quarantine regulations"

6. Behavior in the press center

- Before entering the press center, you are required to thoroughly disinfect your hands
- Take an assigned seat in the press center
- Mouth and nose protection in the form of an FFP-2 mask must be worn at all times
- Disinfect all contact surfaces you come into contact with
- As soon as you leave your seat for a longer period of time, you must clean your workplace thoroughly with the disinfection materials provided

7. Interview-Zone

- Interviews only take place outdoors in strict compliance with distance and hygiene regulations
- The minimum distance between the interview partners is indicated by appropriate floor markings
- Pay attention to the markings and wear an FFP2 mask
- For audio recordings, use a selfie stick or similar to keep the distance

8. Catering

- You will receive a packed lunch at the press center for each day, which must be reserved in advance
- A selection of cold and hot drinks is available at the Press Center reception.
- Water is available at all times in disposable PET bottles for self-service
